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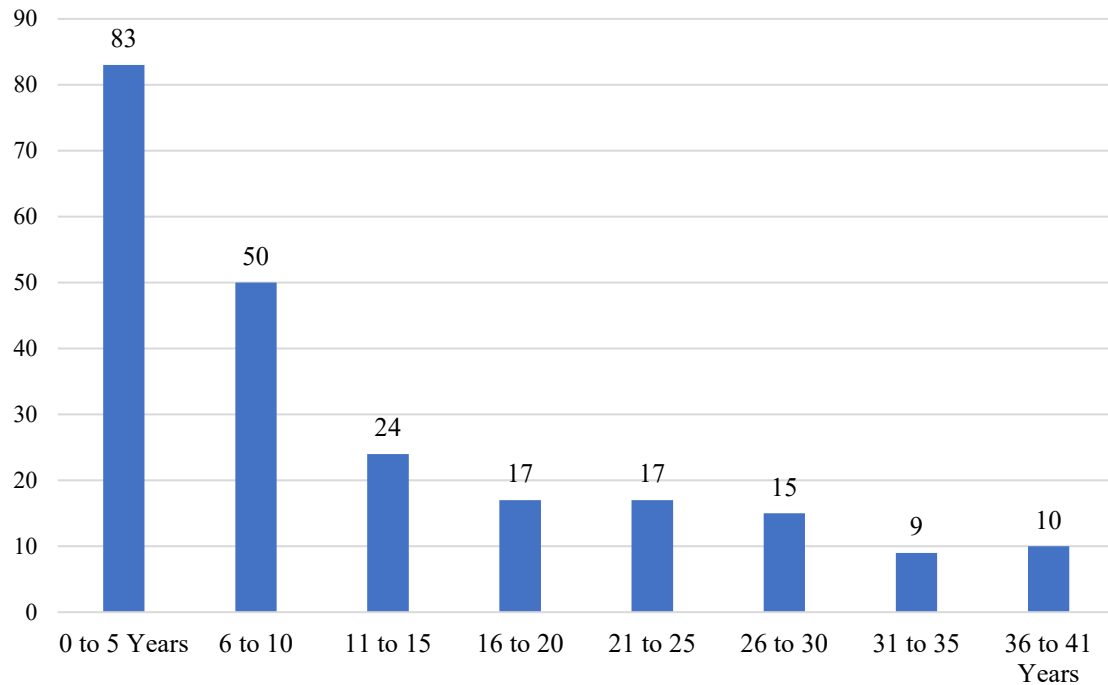


Executive Summary

Between July 8, 2023, and November 20, 2023, 261 individuals responded to the VAC Website Usability Survey. Among those 261 respondents, 226 completed the survey in its entirety. This sample description will focus on those 226 individuals. Among those 226, 225 (99%) identified as AA members, 1 did not identify as an AA member. Of the 225 AA members, 222 reported they were sober for an average of 16 years, ranging from 90 days to 43 years.

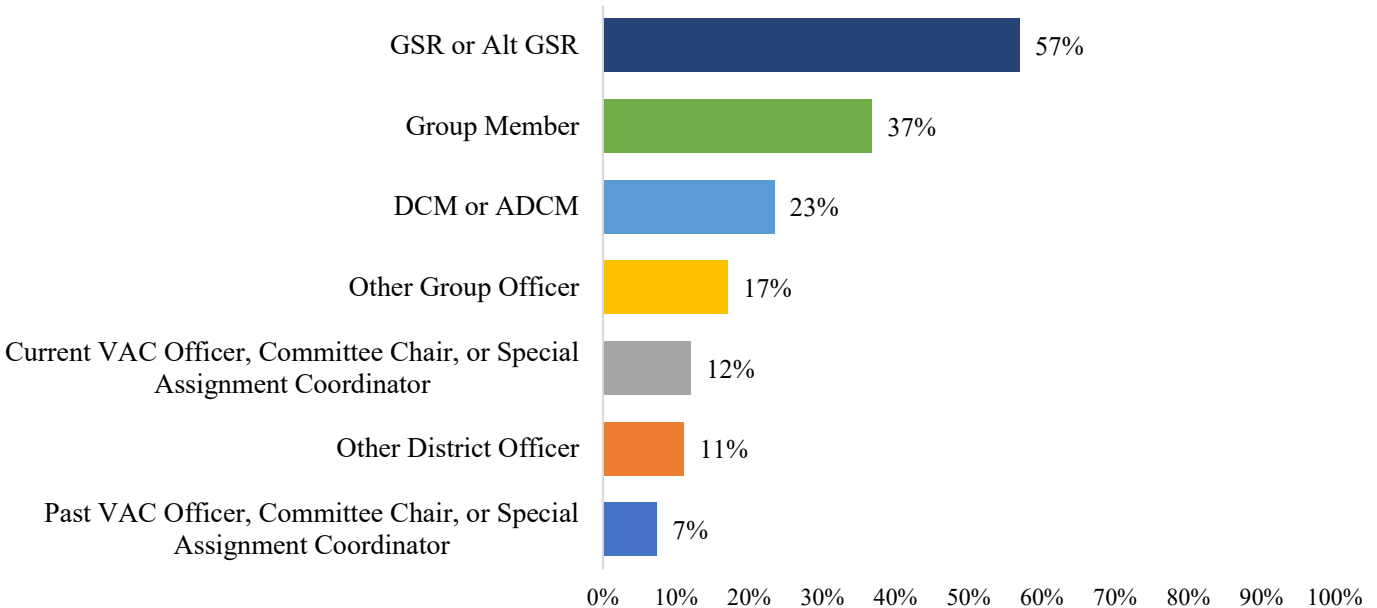
Likewise, respondents varied in number of years in service – from less than 1 year to 41 years, averaging 12 years of service. As evidenced by Figure 1, most (83 of 225 or 37%) were in their first 5 years of service, followed by 6 to 10 years of service for 22% (50 of 225).

The survey also asked respondents to advise on their affiliation with the Virginia Area. They were offered a number of different positions, and asked to select all that apply. Figure 2 indicates that more than half of the 218 who answered the question were GSRs or Alt GSRs (124 of 218 or 57%); while 80 (37%) reported they were group members, followed by 51 (23%) DCMs and ADCMs. Among the 218, they reported an average of 1.70 positions, ranging from 1 to 7.

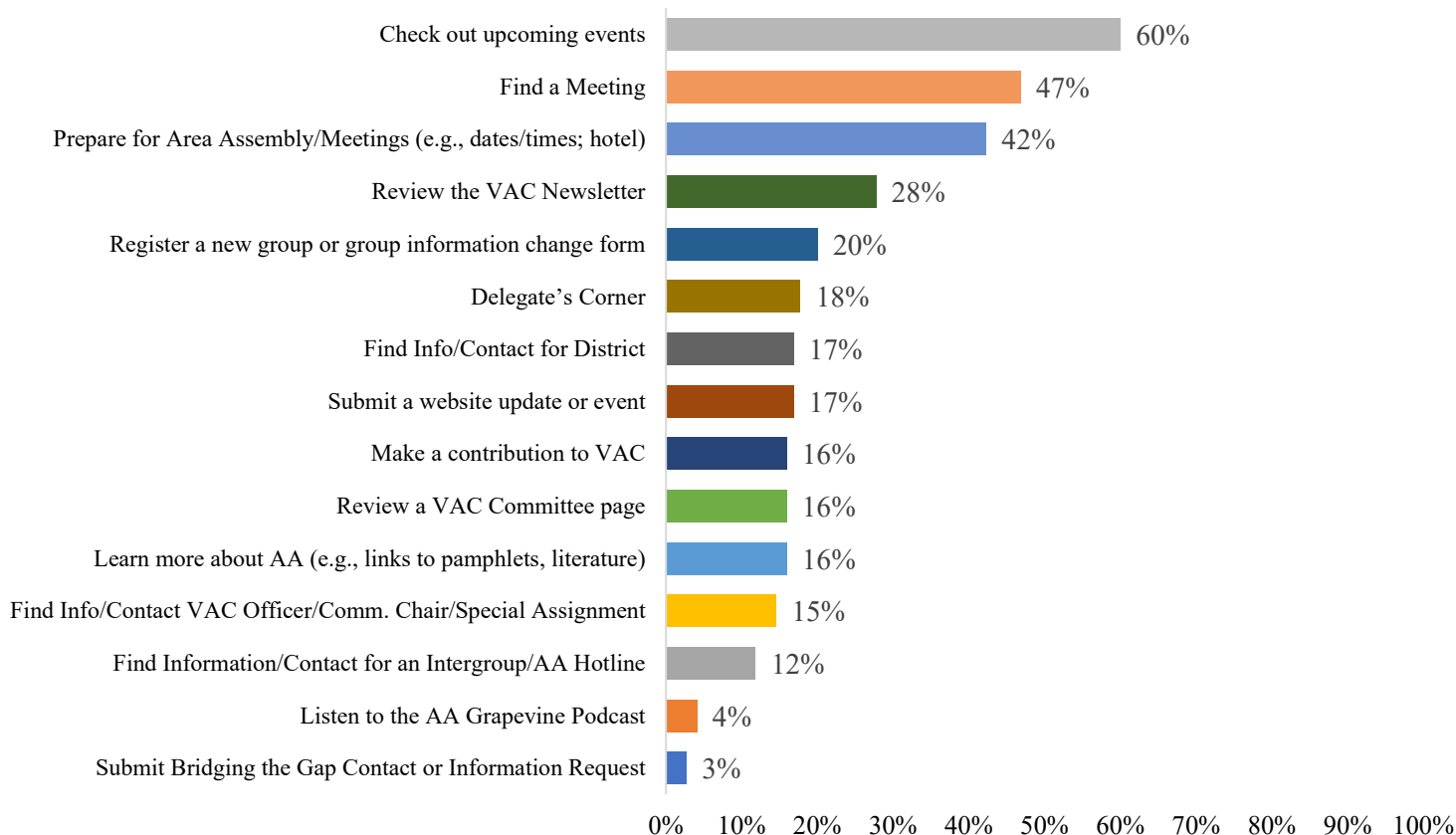
The survey asked the District/Area. A total of 41 Districts were represented in the survey, among the 201 individuals who answered this question.

- District 29-South of the James had the highest number (17 or 8.5% of all respondents);
- District 28-Woodbridge with 12 (6%);
- District 19-Roanoke Valley and District 30-Fredericksburg, both had 11 (5.5%);
- District 21-Springfield had 10 (or 5%);
- District 14-Norfolk and District 23-Virginia Beach both with 8 (4%);
- District 5-Fairfax, had 7 (3.5%);
- District 4-Dulles, District 13-Southwest Virginia, District 24-Western Tidewater, District 37-North East Richmond and District 38-Historic Virginia had 6 (3%);
- District 1-Del Ray, District 9-Heart of Virginia, District 31-Mountain View, and District 42-Centre ville had 5 (2.5%);
- District 2-Arlington, District 3-Piedmont, District 10-Loudon, District 15-Northern Neck, District 26-Wincheseter, District 33-Manassas, District 35-Fauquier, District 36-Southside, District 39-Piedmont, had 4 (2%) respondents per District;
- District 11-Mount Vernon, District 17-South Piedmont, District 22-Shenandoah Valley, District 40-Skyline, District 43-North of the James, District 47-Augusta, with 3 (1.5%);
- District 6-Falls Church, District 18-City of Richmond, District 32-Oceanfront, District 44-Richmond West had 2 (1%); and
- The remaining districts, District 8-Hampton; District 12-Newport News; District 16-South Central; District 41-Vienna; and District 45-Old Town had 1 respondent (0.5%).

Reasons for Visiting Website

Of those who completed the survey, 220 provided one or more reasons why they visited the VAC website. The most frequent reason was to check out upcoming events (132 responses or 60%); followed by finding a meeting (103 or 47%) and to prepare for the Area Assembly or Meeting (93 or 42%). Overall, respondents reported on average 3.29 reasons, ranging from 1 to 7 reasons.

Additional Insights

We found that most respondents visit the site monthly; about the same number visit weekly and quarterly. However, about 25% have almost never visited the site (but responded anyway).

Some further insights are below:

More than 77% are satisfied with the website's content.
More than 80% can easily find what they are looking for.

Event Posting

- Almost 80% of respondents understand about posting an event
- But it was about 50 / 50 that respondents had ever submitted an event
- For those who have submitted an event, 85% were happy with the time it took, and 90% were satisfied with the accuracy.

As to the ease of finding a meeting (as if you were a newcomer), just over 75% thought it was easy or very easy.

Just over 80% thought our content aligned with the Traditions, but 15% were unsure.

More than 75% felt that the site is easy to read and is visually appealing.

An overwhelming majority (85%) would like to see pages dedicated to the GSRs and DCMs.

As to how respondents access our website, it was a virtual tie between Computer and Smart Phone. And most of them felt it was easy to access from either device.

A total of 201 write-in responses were received of which 70 were turned into Action Items.

35 respondents agreed to be contacted by the Committee, which we are in the process of doing.

Additional Features

There were several insights into additional features that respondents thought would be helpful in improving the website. The responses varied widely, encompassing requests for various additions and improvements to the website. Some suggested practical enhancements like adding Spanish resources, District website links, YPAA information, budget transparency, and email contact for home groups. Opportunities for service, special projects, and a section for contributions were also highlighted. Respondents also recommended digitized films, links to sister areas, better District maps, and password-protected conference concerns, etc. Requests for clarity on positions, tutorials on Assemblies, and a personal stories section were also noted.

How Can We Improve the Website?

The responses varied, with some respondents offering specific suggestions for improvement, while others expressed satisfaction with the current website design. Specific suggestions included restoring the option to find meetings by district, considering a drop-down menu for committees, and fixing broken links, such as the one for the Remote Communities Toolkit. Some respondents provided feedback on the website's usability, such as difficulty with expanding and collapsing selections on smartphones. Others emphasized the importance of focusing on helping newcomers and suggested linking to Intergroup and District websites for coordinated updates. Overall, there was a mix of suggestions for enhancements, expressions of satisfaction, and requests for clarification on certain features.

Action Items – Summary

- Continue to improve meeting listings.
- Link Spanish resources and AA.org to Spanish meetings.
- Add links to District websites and state YPAA information.
- Offer digitized films, establish links with sister areas, and enhance District maps.
- Clarify the roles of each position and provide tutorials on Assemblies.
- Restore the option to find meetings by District.
- Consider implementing a drop-down menu for committees and address broken links.
- Improve usability, especially on smart phones, for expanding and collapsing sections.
- Maintain a clear focus on helping newcomers and prioritize easy access to resources for them.

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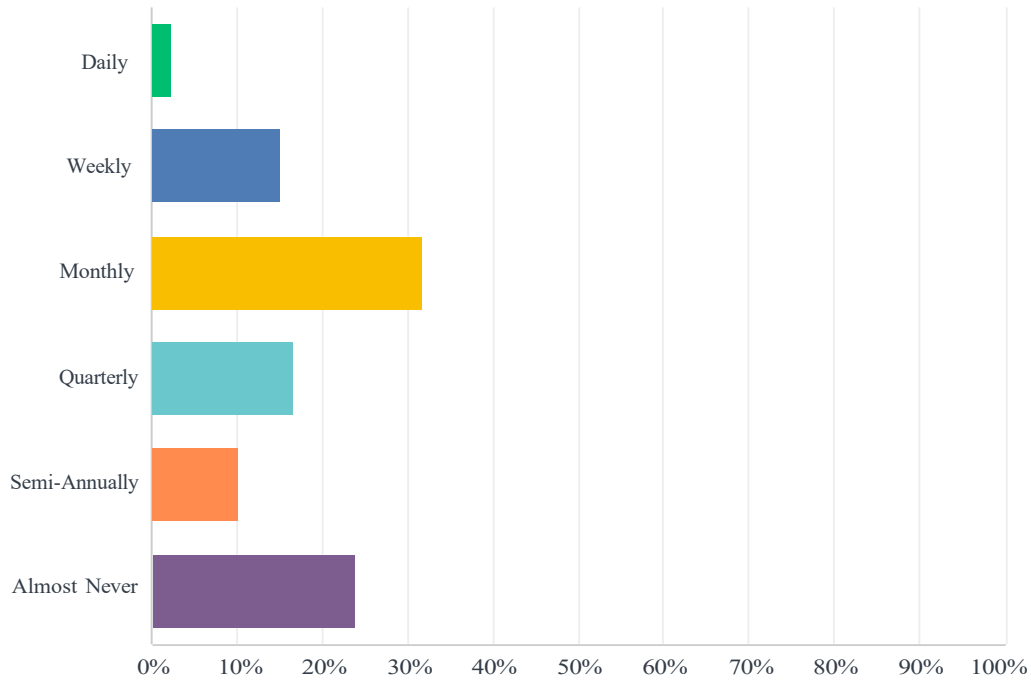

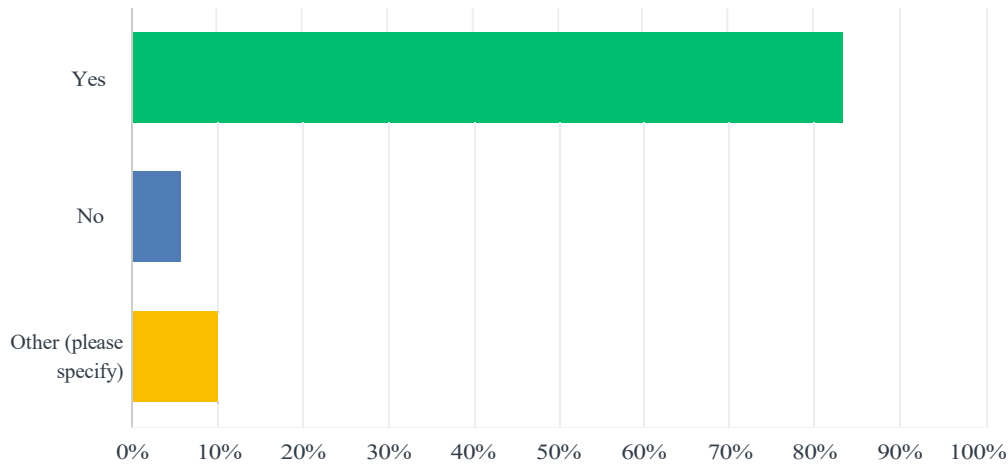

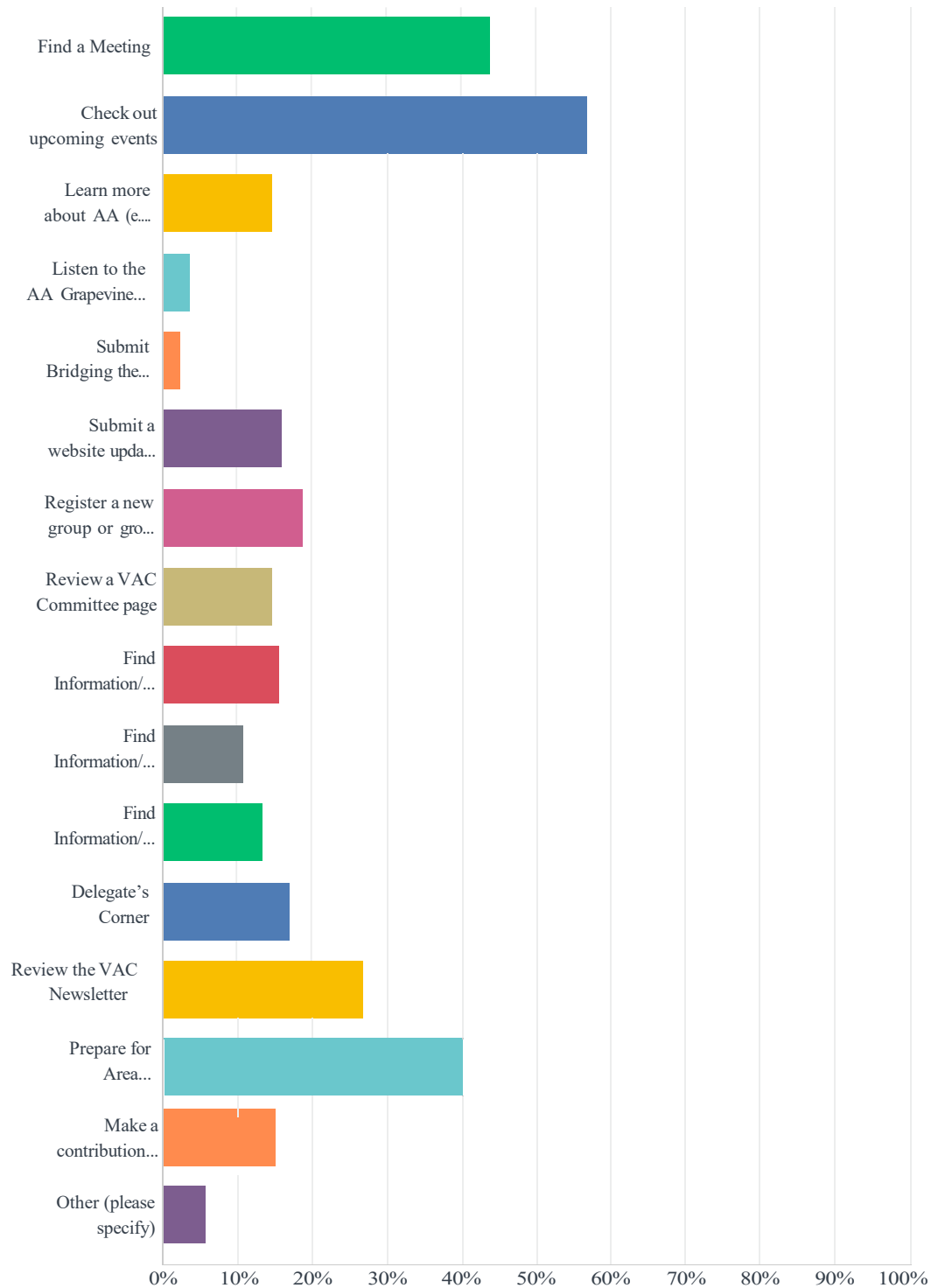
